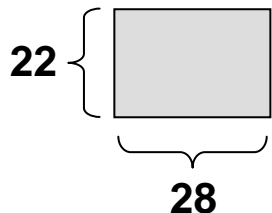

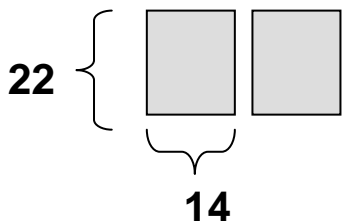
Step 1.

Purchase a standard 28 x 22 inch poster board.



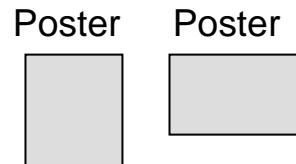
Step 2:

Cut the board in half resulting in two 14 x 22 inch pieces.



Step 3:

Take one of the remaining pieces and use it for your poster. You may turn it either direction. See contest rules for further restrictions.



Step 4:

Write your name, age, grade level, full address, county, state, and a brief artwork interpretive statement, should be affixed to the **back** of the poster board in the upper left hand corner. Include your signature on the back to ensure that it is your original work.



Step 5:

Take your poster to any Brazoria County library before **January 30, 2009**.



Brazoria County Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration Committee 2010 Youth Poster Contest

WHO:

All students ages 8 – 18 throughout Brazoria County are eligible.

Contest divisions: (Category I: ages 8-10, Category II: Ages 11-12, Category III: Ages 13-15 and Category 16-18.)

WHEN:

Awards announced by February 11, 2010

Deadline for receipt of posters: Posters may be delivered to any Brazoria County Library before January 30, 2010.

WHERE:

Contest: Judging Location to be determined

DETAILS:

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 posters in each category. We will provide certificates of achievement to all who submit posters. The theme of the contests this year is: **“Love – Stand - Serve.”**

RULES:

1. The poster must be created by a youth, or team of youths from Brazoria County.
2. The poster should express the theme of the current year's celebration.
3. Well-known cartoon figures or corporate trademarks may not be used on posters, because they are copyrighted or legally protected.
4. All posters must be designed on, or affixed to .016 ply construction poster board (solid fiberboard) of 14-inch x 22-inch dimensions (one-half a standard poster board size). They may be horizontal or vertical.
5. Posters may be produced by any medium-watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils, collage, so long as they are not three-dimensional objects.
6. The submitter's name, age, full address, county, state, and a brief artwork interpretive statement, should be affixed to the back of the poster board in the upper left hand corner.
7. Posters should specify age category: Category I: ages 8-10, Category II: Ages 11-12, Category III: Ages 13-15 and Category 16-18.
8. The submitting youth should sign the back of the poster to certify that the poster is the youth's original work.
9. **Posters must be delivered to any Brazoria County Library before January 30, 2010.**
10. Entries will be evaluated on the following criteria: A. Development of theme B. Color C. Originality/creativity D. Neatness E. Complexity
11. Once submitted the poster becomes property of the MLKCC to be used as the Committee sees fit. The selected poster may be digitally altered to assure quality reproduction.
